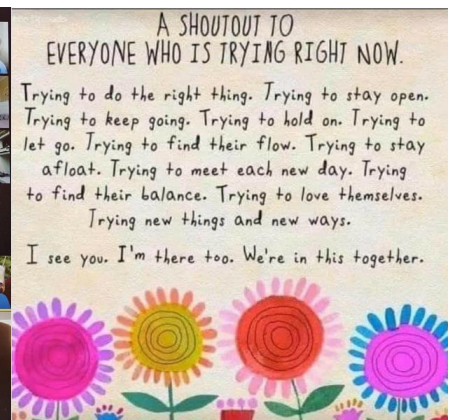
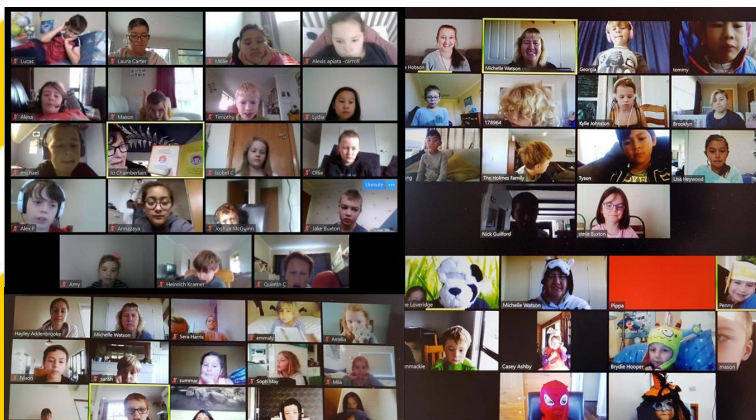
Room 3: Ruby and Ella Jane - awesome attitude in Zoom meetings and trying really hard with their reading.
